These proposed additional expenditures are in addition to those necessary to achieve the New Jersey Student learning standards."

#### Supporting Statement

Separate Proposal #1 will provide for salaries and benefits for certified instructional staff to provide a more comprehensive multi-tiered system of support and supervision for mathematics instruction. Voter approval of this proposal will represent a permanent increase in the tax levy of 2.15% meaning the tax levy will increase by 2.15% and the dollar amount of \$459,548 will become permanent part of the general fund base budget moving forward.
