- INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING**
- Press the button to the right of the candidate of your choice; a green "X" will appear next to your selection.
 - To change a selection, press the button again. The green "X" will disappear and you may make a new selection.
 - If you wish to cast a WRITE-IN vote (you may not write-in any name that is printed on the ballot for the same office), go to the WRITE-IN column and press the button next to WRITE-IN across from the office you wish to write-in. A blinking green "X" will appear. Using the alphabetical keyboard below, enter the name of the person of your choice, one letter at a time. To make a space between first and middle name or initial and last name use the arrow pointing to the right on the keyboard. To make a correction, use the arrow pointing to the left. The name you ENTER will appear in the display to the left of the keyboard. When you have entered the whole name, proof it, then press the enter button on the keyboard. Your choice is recorded and removed from the display. Do not press the cast vote button until all other choices are complete. (Each write-in is a separate entry.)
WARNING! An improperly cast write-in vote will be void. Be sure that your write-in vote is cast in the WRITE-IN column on the same line as the office for which you are casting the write-in vote.
 - To vote on the PUBLIC QUESTIONS press the button to the right of the word "YES" or "NO"; a green "X" will appear next to your selection.
 - After ALL selections have been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON located in the lower right corner. This electronically records all of your votes.
 - Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.

<p>STATE QUESTION NO. 1</p> <p>CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO GIVE CERTAIN VETERANS' BENEFITS TO RESIDENTS OF CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITIES</p> <p>Do you approve amending the Constitution to allow eligible veterans to receive the value of the veterans' property tax deduction if they reside in a continuing care retirement community? The deduction shall be provided to a continuing care retirement community, which shall pass the value of the deduction on to the eligible veterans who live there.</p> <p>INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT</p> <p>This amendment would allow eligible veterans who live in continuing care retirement communities to receive the value of the \$250 property tax deduction currently granted to veterans who reside in a private residence. This amendment would give the veterans' property tax deduction to continuing care retirement communities on behalf of eligible veterans.</p> <p>The total amount of the deduction given to a continuing care retirement community would be based on the number of eligible veterans who live there. The community would be required to pass the value of the deduction on to each eligible veteran.</p> <p>Deductions would not be paid to continuing care retirement communities that are property tax-exempt. An eligible veteran who receives the value of a deduction through a continuing care retirement community cannot receive a veterans' property tax deduction on any other home he or she owns or in which a spouse lives.</p> <p>Eligible veterans must be New Jersey residents. They must have served in the military in time of war, or other emergency. They must be honorably discharged.</p>	<p>LOCAL PROPOSAL #1</p> <p>The Board of Education of the Borough of Florham Park in the County of Morris, New Jersey is authorized to (a) upgrade and renovate Briarwood Elementary School, Brooklake Elementary School and Ridgedale Middle School and (b) expend and issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$19,839,493 for such projects. <p>EXPLANATORY STATEMENT</p> <p>The Board of Education is seeking to undertake comprehensive, district-wide facilities and educational space improvements and renovations. The improvements will be presented to the voters via two proposals. The State has agreed to pay for between 34% and 40% of the cost of the improvements if the proposals are approved. This State aid reduces the taxpayers' share of each of the projects to between 60% and 66% of the total project cost. <u>Such State funding will only be available if the respective proposals pass.</u></p>	<p>Proposal #1 includes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briarwood Elementary School: roof replacement, conversion of computer lab to classroom, and lighting/ceiling replacement. Brooklake Elementary School: roof replacement, boiler replacement, lighting/ceiling replacement, HVAC upgrades, main office renovation, boiler replacement and renovate media center and computer lab. Ridgedale Middle School: roof repairs; renovate auditorium, wellness center, wood shop and media center; HVAC upgrades; boiler replacement; generator replacement and lighting/ceiling replacement. <p>Proposal #1 improvements would be undertaken at a cost not to exceed \$19,839,493.</p> <p>Proposal #2 includes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briarwood Elementary School: replace windows and flooring and renovate CST. Brooklake Elementary School: renovate bathrooms, replace flooring.
