EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

THE PROJECT

The Board is seeking to undertake the replacement and repair of the existing synthetic turf field at the main football stadium along with associated site work and track repair.

TOTAL PROJECT COSTS

The total cost of the project shall not exceed \$941,250. The Board has received an award of State funding in the amount of 40% of the total project costs which State funding reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 60%.

40% STATE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT

The Board will receive State aid for the project in the form of debt service aid in the amount of 40%. This State aid reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 60% of the total project cost. Such State funding will only be available if the referendum passes. The Board expects to fund its 60% of debt service with monies currently on deposit in the Capital Reserve Fund so it is anticipated that no new tax dollars will be raised to pay for the project.

PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Watchung Hills Regional High School District, New Jersey is authorized to undertake a school facilities project consisting of replacement and repair of the existing synthetic turf field at the main football stadium along with associated site work and track repair. The Board is authorized to expend on such project and issue bonds for such project in an amount not to exceed \$941,250. The State has agreed to provide debt service aid in the amount of 40% of the "final costs" of the school facilities project. All of the costs of the project are "final eligible costs."

- 3 After your selection has been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON located in the lower right corner. This electronically records your vote.
- 4 Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.
