

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO
MORRIS COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION VOTERS**

Dear Voter,

Considering the ongoing novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Governor Murphy signed P.L. 2020, c. 72 on August 28, 2020, which requires County Clerks to send all Active registered voters a Vote-by-Mail Ballot for the upcoming November 3, 2020 General Election.

Enclosed please find your General Election Vote-by-Mail Ballot. **Please be advised that P.L. 2020, c. 72 requires you to sign the Certificate of Mail-In Voter on the flap of the white ballot envelope notwithstanding the fact that you may not have applied for this ballot, but instead received this ballot automatically under P.L. 2020, c. 72.** .

If you want to participate in the General Election, please use the enclosed Vote-by-Mail Ballot. A limited number of Polling Places will be available for voters on Election Day where voters may vote **only by Provisional Paper Ballots** or return their own Vote-by-Mail ballot. If you have a disability and need an accessible Vote-by-Mail ballot, please contact the Morris County Clerk's Office at (973) 285-6066 or you may go to your assigned polling place, which will provide you with access to an in-person accessible voting device on Election Day.

Per P.L. 2020, c. 72, our office has provided a postage paid envelope for the return of your ballot through the United States Postal Service. You are not required to attach a stamp. You may also choose to deposit your ballot in a secure ballot drop box located throughout the county or deliver your ballot to your assigned polling place on Election Day. We have included detailed instructions on how you must complete your Vote-by-Mail Ballot. Please return your ballot as soon as possible. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than 8:00 pm on November 3, 2020. The deadline for delivering your ballot in-person to the Morris County Board of Elections, placing it in one of the secure ballot drop boxes, or delivering it to your polling place by 8:00 pm on November 3, 2020.
